Your Hebrew Lesson

The Hebrew Word for victory is: <u>Nestach</u> = Nun -Stade-Chet. It has several facets of meanings: <u>victory</u>, <u>perpetuity</u>, <u>forever</u>, and <u>completeness</u>. True victory is one that is complete, lasts forever, into perpetuity; else it is not a true victory but a temporary one of dominance in a situation that has no long lasting effects. Who has won the ballgame? You can only say so at the end of the game, for the score can go back and forth many times over the course of a game, yet the winner is only determined by the final score, the end result, after all is said and done, who really won. <u>GOD</u> gives us the victory. HE has totally secured it at The Cross, is enforcing it through us and by HIS SPIRIT, will come back and sit on HIS Throne and rule for a 1000 years, then have a final judgment, and then only HIS people remain. Will you be one?

<u>What do you say when</u>

You are misunderstood? Make you case, defend your position without being defensive, on occasion go on the offensive without being offensive. Look to move everyone forward without manipulation, but with understanding. Give it time, everyone's at a different place, most everyone thinks they're right or wants to believe that they're right, while a few don't care if they're wrong but will push forward with their views anyway. As far as it is possible, be at peace with all men, don't strive, love. Love people. 
